When a child dependant turns 21, proof of the child's status is required in order to determine the contribution rate. The Scheme will send a letter to the member with a copy to Group Salaries. Upon receipt of the letter, the member is required to complete this form.

The completed and signed form should be submitted to Group Salaries at Nampak Centre or faxed immediately to 011 444 9348 before or by the 7th of the month.
